The ideal Project Scientist will be able to direct their own independent research project with oversight and input from the principal investigator. The incumbent will also assist with lab management tasks and help oversee the projects of others in the laboratory, including training and providing scientific direction for graduate students, undergraduate students and postdocs in the laboratory. The ideal candidate will also assist with manuscript writing and grant preparation and will also have the opportunity to present their work at scientific meetings.

Candidates must have a PhD in Genetics, Molecular Biology, Genomics, Bioinformatics or other related area.

The appropriate series and appointment at the Assistant, Associate, or Full Project Scientist level will be based on the candidate's qualifications and experience. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and based on the University of California pay scales.
